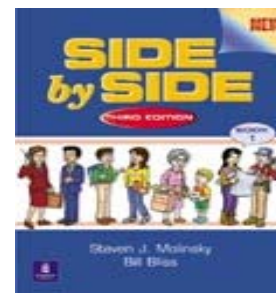

- relate personal experience, interests, and opinions in small group & classroom settings
