### IV. VERB + *GERUND* or *INFINITIVE* (change in meaning)

<b>forget</b> (forget to perform a responsibility, duty, task) <b>regret</b> (regret to say, to tell someone, to inform someone of some bad news) <b>remember</b> (remember to perform a responsibility, duty, task) <b>stop</b> (pause one activity to do something else) <b>try</b> (make an effort)	<b>TO + VERB</b>
