

PHRASAL VERBS

VERB + PREPOSITION
(SPECIAL MEANING VERBS)

I. SEPARABLE - the verb can be separated from its preposition by a noun or pronoun

bring back	fill out	put away	throw away
call up	give back	put on	throw out
clean up	hand in	take back	try on
cross out	hang up	take down	turn down
do over	look up	take off	turn off
drop off	pick out	take out	turn on
figure out	pick up	think over	write down

A. WORD ORDER - NOUN OBJECTS

VERB	PREPOSITION	DIRECT OBJECT
<i>PUT</i>	<i>ON</i>	<i>my boots</i>

VERB	DIRECT OBJECT	PREPOSITION
<i>PUT</i>	<i>my boots</i>	<i>ON</i>

B. WORD ORDER - PRONOUN OBJECTS

VERB	DIRECT OBJ PRO.	PREPOSITION
<i>PUT</i>	<i>them</i>	<i>ON</i>

VERB	PREPOSITION	PREPOSITION
<i>PUT</i>	<i>ON</i>	<i>them</i>

II. INSEPARABLE - the verb can NEVER be separated from its preposition

call on	look through
get along with	look up to
get over	pick on
hear from	run into
look for	take after

A. WORD ORDER - NOUN OBJECTS

VERB	PREPOSITION	DIRECT OBJECT
<i>HEAR</i>	<i>FROM</i>	<i>George</i>

VERB	DIRECT OBJECT	PREPOSITION
<i>HEAR</i>	<i>George</i>	<i>FROM</i>

B. WORD ORDER - PRONOUN OBJECTS

VERB	PREPOSITION	DIRECT OBJ. PRO.
<i>HEAR</i>	<i>FROM</i>	<i>him</i>

VERB	DIRECT OBJ. PRO.	PREPOSITION
<i>HEAR</i>	<i>him</i>	<i>FROM</i>
