

ADJECTIVES

I. **OVERVIEW** - Adjectives describe nouns & pronouns often answering the questions *what kind? which one? & how many?*

II. RULES

A. Adjectives always appear BEFORE nouns

- two intelligent high school students

B. Adjectives can also follow linking verbs

- He is moody. The chili smells delicious.
- You seem angry. The teacher feels sick today.
- She looks puzzled. The cake tastes too sweet.

C. Adjectives are always SINGULAR (never add the plural -s to adjectives!!)

- pretty girls six dollars
- hardworking students eight-foot wall

D. Nouns can function as adjectives

- the French book a toy store
- some fruit salad a college town

E. Adjectives referring to nationalities and languages are CAPITALIZED

- a Mexican dance my English class
- the American government Canadian folklore
